Green Hotel Awardee Celebrates Earth Day


The Bellevue Resort – Bohol makes mangrove cleanup a monthly initiative in Panglao Island



Following the success of its Earth Hour 60KM cycling and 1000 trees planting initiative last March 27, 2021, The Bellevue Resort continues to play a significant role in raising awareness for environmental protection. In its commitment to help save the environment, the two-time ASEAN Green hotel awardee joined Earth Day.

Gathering as early as 7am on April 22, 2021, employees from The Bellevue Resort conducted a mangrove kayak clean-up at the Doljo Mangrove Rainforest in an effort to continuously keep the mangrove forests of Panglao Island clean. Total of 48.5 kilograms of assorted non-biodegradable garbage were collected which mostly consisted of plastic bottles, cellophane, rubbers, styrofoam and other wastes. The resort has strictly implemented its health and safety measures throughout the event to ensure everyone's safety.

The Bellevue Resort vows to make this a monthly activity to support the efforts to protect the mangroves of Panglao Island, Bohol. The resort is a recipient of the ASEAN Green Hotel Standard for two consecutive years.
